

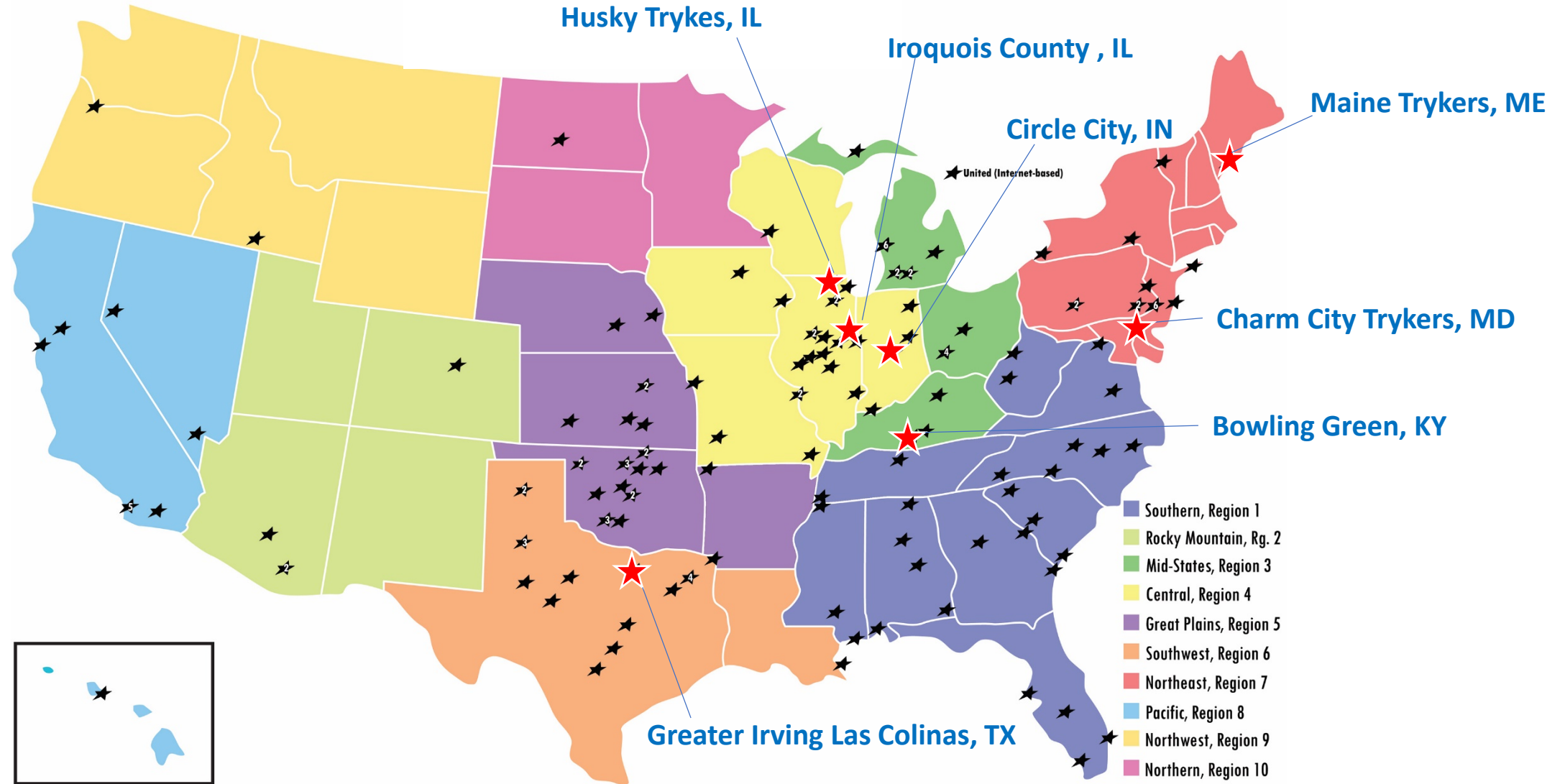


ANNUAL REPORT | OCTOBER 2019

- 1,783 students made applications

Recent Program Updates

- Only students accepted into a **graduate level program** are eligible. Undergraduate juniors or seniors will no longer be considered for an award.
- Students are required to fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and supply us with the **Student Aid Report (SAR)** in order to apply.
- All applications and **supporting documents due early May**
- **All chapter sponsored students are considered for an award**
- The Personal Statement prompt has been updated to clearly ask for the elements the students writing will be judged upon.
- Reminder: **Alyssa Magalski, Charitable Programs Coordinator** is the ARC staff person in charge of the Scholars Program

Reminders
